

## **Helping Hands Scholarship**

HandsOn Northwest North Carolina values the role education plays in increasing the capacity of nonprofit organizations in our region. As an incentive to participate in training and local networking, HandsOn Northwest North Carolina is pleased to offer the Helping Hands Scholarship Program. This program offers partial scholarships to nonprofit staff, board members, or volunteers in Forsyth, Davidson, Davie, Stokes, Surry and Yadkin Counties who are interested in developing competency in areas critical to the daily operation of their organization. If you or your nonprofit can afford to pay the entire fee for a class, please do so and allow other nonprofits the opportunity to benefit from this scholarship.

**Program Information.** Partial scholarships are available to attend Nonprofit Essentials Certificate Program offered through Wake Forest University's Pro Humanitate Institute and HandsOn NWNC. Scholarships are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. All scholarships are subject to class space and funding availability. Applicants who are awarded a scholarship and then cancel are responsible for paying any cancelation fees.

Nonprofit Essentials Certificate Program. This program offers ten skill building courses critical for the daily operation and success of nonprofit organizations, including Governance, Budgeting and Finance, Human Resources, Strategic Planning, Fund Development, Collaboration, Evaluation and Advocacy, Communications, Grant Writing, and a class on an Emerging Issue impacting nonprofits. All classes are held at the **The Winston-Salem Foundation** building, located at **751 West Fourth Street, Suite 200, Winston-Salem, 27101** from 12:00 pm to 4:30 pm, and include lunch. Please check the HandsOn NWNC website at for specific class dates, locations and any changes to the schedule.

**Eligibility**. Applicants must be current staff or board members of nonprofits within Forsyth, Davidson, Davie, Stokes, Surry or Yadkin Counties and will be awarded on a first come, first served basis. *Limit one scholarship per person/organization each year*.

Scholarship Payment. Scholarships cover one-half of the cost for one/multiple classes or one-half of the cost of the entire 10 class series. All scholarships will be paid by HandsOn NWNC directly to the Nonprofit Essentials Certificate Program and HandsOn NWNC will enroll the scholarship recipient in the program. The scholarship recipient will only be responsible for the remaining balance due.
